

## PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE INTRODUCTION OF 30KPH SPEED LIMIT IN RESIDENTIAL ESTATES

Kildare County Council is undertaking a review of speed limits in residential estates and wishes to engage with interested parties in a non-statutory consultation process.

The review of current speed limits is being undertaken to ensure that housing estate roads are as safe as possible for pedestrians, cyclists and especially children.

In this regard, Residents Associations/Members of the Public are invited to make submissions to the council suggesting residential estates for the possible introduction of a 30kph speed limit.
