- How can we build a more inclusive Europe?

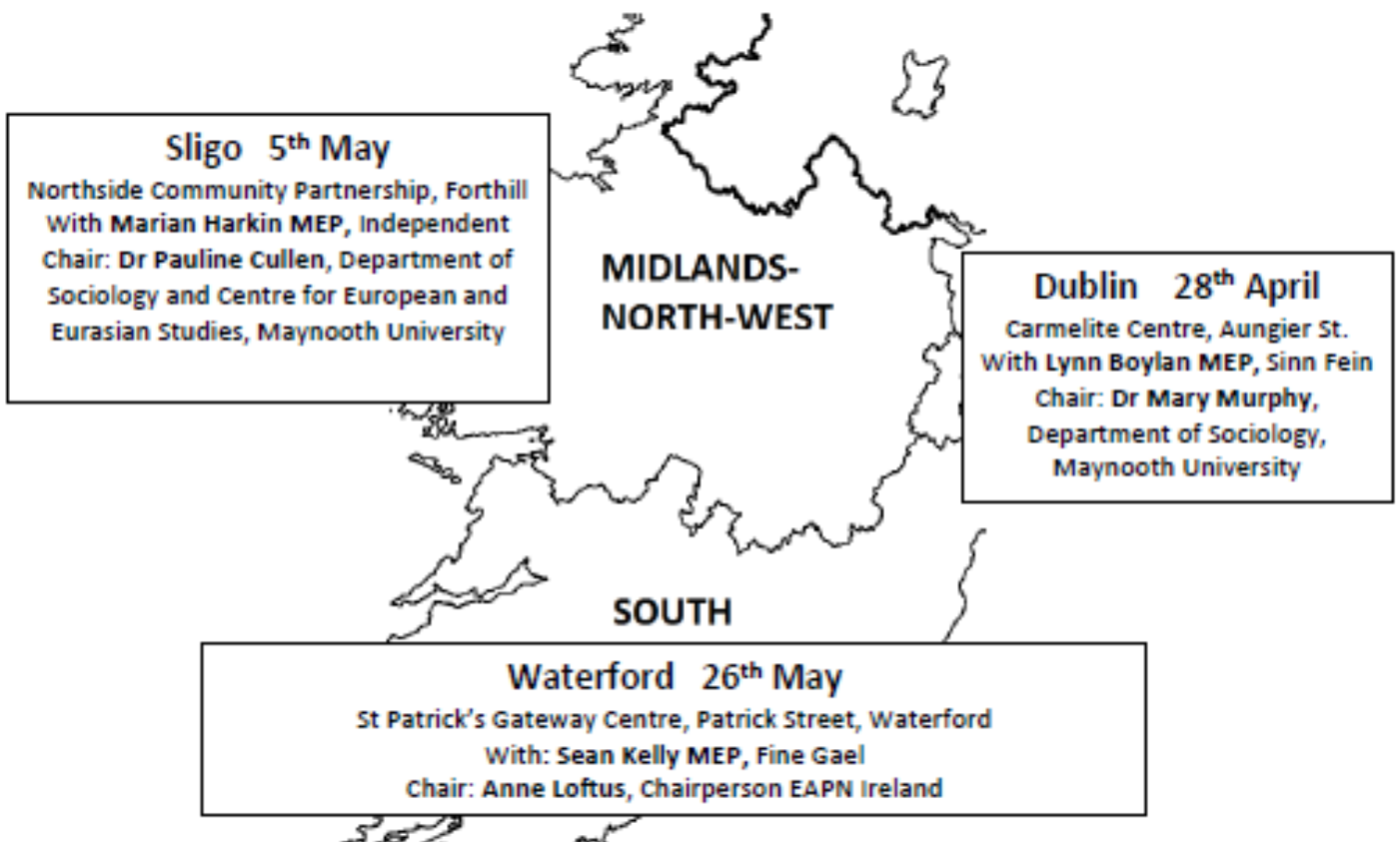
