Symptoms can include; haemorrhage, strokes, seizures, headaches. Neurological partial/full paralysis, tremors, weakness, numbness, fatigue, memory and concentration difficulties, speech and eyesight problems. The type, severity, combination and duration of symptoms vary,

depending on the location of the cavernoma. 1 in 625 people have a cavernoma. Cavernomas can either be symptomatic or asymptomatic. Cavernomas causing symptoms are rare. At least 1 in 400,000 people are diagnosed with a symptomatic cavernoma each year. Cavernomas can


