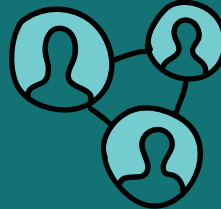

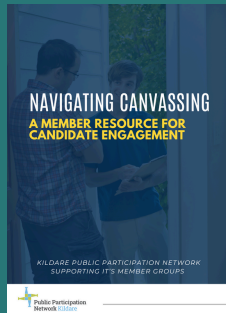

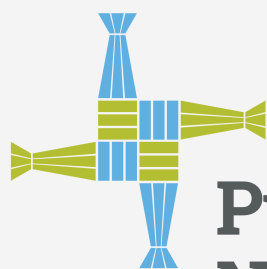
The Department of Rural and Community Development approved Kildare PPN's move towards a CLG on Friday 29th November.
